Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)
 Treatment for opioid dependence. Services are provided only in conjunction with therapeutic treatment and counseling after less restrictive treatments have been failed attempts.

Individual Therapy
 Address social, emotional, behavioral and/or substance abuse needs.

Case Management/CPST Services
 Linking, referring, advocating, collaborating, monitoring and skill building.

Intensive Outpatient for Alcohol and other Drugs
 Multiple weekly sessions including community sober activities.

Substance Abuse Crisis Intervention
 Direct response to crisis or emergency situations experienced by a client, family member and/or significant other.

Drug Testing
 Identification and analysis of drugs (including prescription medication).

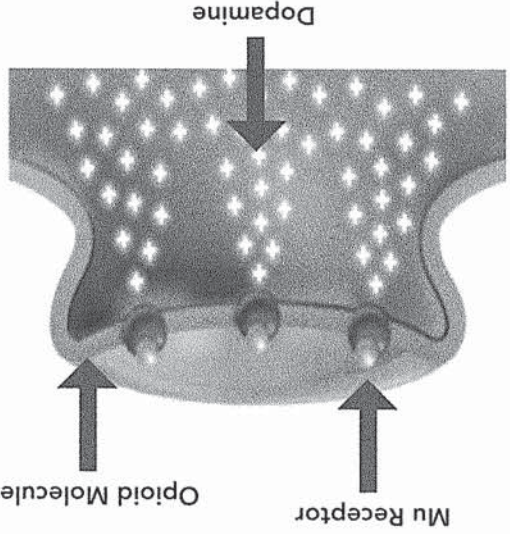

HOW DO OPIOIDS WORK?

When opioids enter the bloodstream, they travel to the brain and attach to mu-receptors on the outside of certain cells. This causes a chemical called Dopamine to be released into the brain. Elevated levels of Dopamine cause euphoria (that feeling of being high).

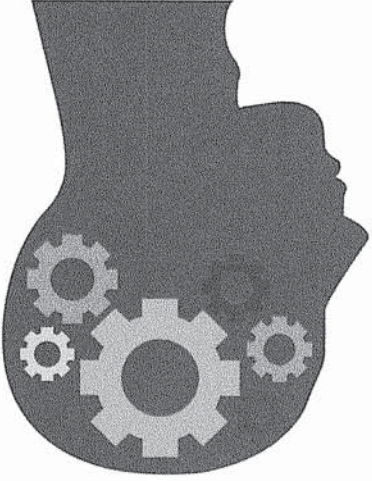

WHAT ARE OPIOIDS?

Natural opioids (morphine, codeine) are substances that are derived from the opium poppy. Endogenous opioids (endorphins) are produced by the human body during exercise. Semi-synthetic opioids (oxycotin, hydrocodone, oxymorphone) are produced in the laboratory from natural opioids. Synthetic opioids (fentanyl, propoxyphene) are manufactured 100% in the lab.
