- Goldman Park Updates
  - Getting Field Leveling Quotes
  - Danielle – Signed her 14-year-old son up for Middie Way Baseball but he was unable to play because the fields are too small for his age group
  - Will replace water fountain inside building
- Sherman Park Update
  - Sherman Park – Lights \$8584.00 from Contractor. Dave Pearce asked if police has a fund for Public Safety that could be used to purchase lights for Parks
  - Julie asked to have posts and cable installed on Wayne Ave side to prevent vehicles from driving inside the Park
  - Drinking Fountain – Will be installed in May
- Financial Update.
  - After Douglass Splash Pad expenditure total approximately \$205,000, after currently approved expenditures
  - Discussed Park Impact Fee accessibility.
  - New Splashpad at Douglass Park \$537,000 Penchura
- Tree City USA –
  - Parks Tree report – Removed 6 trees various locations.
  - Discussed I Tree Academy -data and tree mapping portal
  - ISA Certified Arborist Exam
  - Tree Risk Assessment classes
  - Arbor day Tree planting at Goldman Park
  - Crews will be out pruning in April and May




