Actions You Can Take**Grass & Weeds**

All grass, weeds and wild plants must not exceed six inches in height.

Ordinance 678.01 passed 3-20-2001

**RUMPKE**

- Mattresses and upholstered furniture must be completely sealed in plastic.
- TV sets cannot exceed 32"
- Large item pickup must be scheduled 48hrs in advance.
- Toilet tanks must be removed.
- Freon appliances require paperwork. Contact Rumpke directly.
- Federal law prohibits Rumpke from accepting batteries, tires, or liquids.
- Drywall, concrete, bricks, dirt and rocks are not accepted.
- Drums, barrels, and household containers are not acceptable trash containers and will be assumed trash.

**Yard Maintenance**

Indoor furniture/furnishings, mattresses, appliances may not be stored in any yard, porch, patio, deck or other non-enclosed structure for longer than 48 hours.

**NO Parking on Grass**

Except for temporary parking, all off-street parking must be on hard, dustless surface
Development Code
1218.03
effective 3-1-2018

**Junk Motor Vehicle**

Inoperative or unlicensed motor vehicles shall not be parked, kept or stored on any premises, and vehicles shall not at any time be in a state of major disassembly, disrepair, or in the process of being stripped or dismantled.

IPMC 302.8

**Property Maintenance**

Maintenance includes elimination of peeling paint, deteriorated siding & roofing, missing windows & doors, loose gutters, etc.

Section 302.1 Exterior property and premises shall be maintained in a clean, safe and sanitary condition.

302.7 Accessory structures including detached garages, fences and walls shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair.
