Middletown St. Patrick's Day Festivities Return for Second Year!

MIDDLETOWN, Ohio – The City of Middletown Events is excited to announce its second annual St. Patrick's Day Downtown Parade and Bar Crawl, happening on Saturday, March 15, 2025 beginning at 4 p.m. in Downtown Middletown.

"Last year's St. Patrick's Day celebration was a success, bringing the Middletown community and visitors from across the region to Downtown and turning the street green," Jeri Lewis, Middletown's community projects coordinator, said. "The parade and bar crawl are back in 2025 and we expect an even bigger turnout to join in on the fun!"

The St. Patrick's Parade will travel down the heart of Downtown along Central Ave., featuring the Butler County Sheriff Bag Pipe Band, Cincinnati Caledonian Pipes & Drums, dog groups, jeepers and car clubs, horses, and many other local organizations. The parade will culminate in a Bar Crawl featuring a series of festivities with participating restaurants and establishments offering specials until 9 p.m. However, many establishments will continue to be open past 9 p.m.

In addition to the parade and festivities, a DJ and live music will bring the energy at Governor's Square while street/music performers will be playing throughout the Downtown area. The City encourages everyone to enjoy the Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (DORA), but recommend designating a driver or using a taxi or ride share service.

The City's St. Patrick's Day celebration is not just for adults! After the parade, kids can go to Governor's Square to build leprechaun traps to take home as well as get their face painted!

This is the second St. Patrick's Day event sponsored by the City of Middletown. Other events sponsored by the City of Middletown include Dessert Week, Burger Week, Food Truck Fridays, Movies in the Park, Kids Summer Arts in the Park, Memorial Day Parade, and many more.
